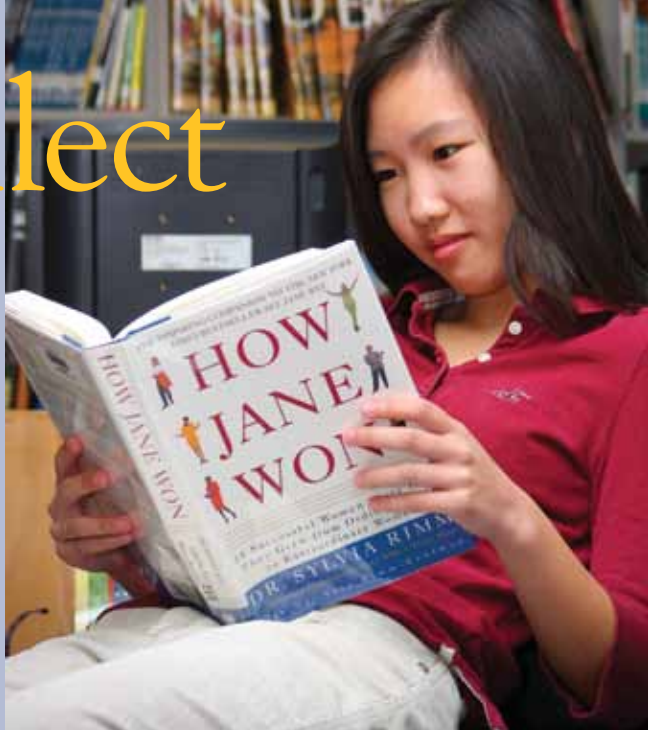
A richly textured curriculum, small classes, and individualized instruction – Millwood School prepares students to meet the world with confidence.

Millwood School is a thriving college preparatory school for students in Junior Kindergarten through Upper School. Our focus is educational excellence in a warm and supportive environment. Millwood builds a firm foundation of academic skills and knowledge by providing students with the tools and environment for learning and discovery. Every grade level has a rigorous core curriculum of language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies. In addition, students have multiple opportunities each year to participate in a broad range of enrichment programs such as speaking events, concerts and plays, and field trips.

Our instruction begins in Junior Kindergarten, and courses are offered in Spanish, French, and Japanese at different grade levels. Students use computers in the classroom beginning in Kindergarten, and instruction in our computer laboratory enhances their proficiency and allows them to take full advantage of technology in their studies. Courses in the arts and music are also offered. These aspects of the curriculum foster creativity, artistic accomplishment, and appreciation of the fine arts. 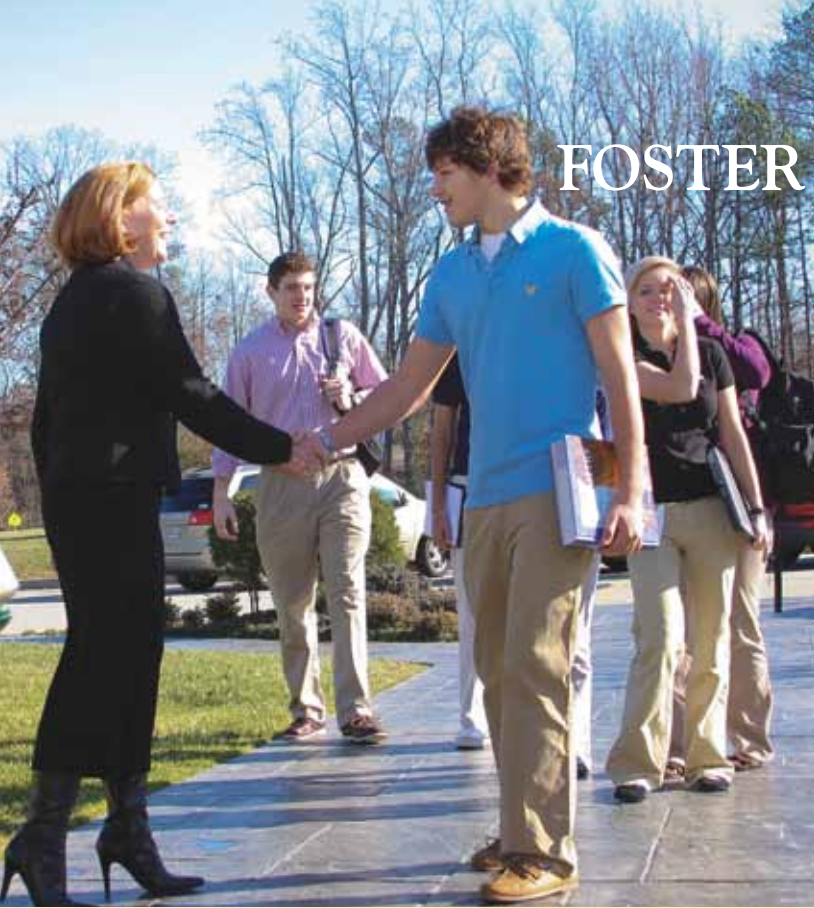
