In addition to offering a strong academic curriculum, we hold our students responsible for good conduct, and we model respectful, honorable behavior for them in every part of school life.

Millwood's "Big Ten" code for self-discipline serves as the guiding principle for behavior in the community of the school. In this secure, consistent environment, Millwood's kindergarten students develop the skills and habits that will support them in everything they do for the rest of their lives.

Millwood School sits on a 79-acre campus in western Chesterfield County, adjacent to the Woodlake community. Our classrooms, computer lab, library, gymnasium, playground, and athletic fields are exceptional, with room to expand as Millwood grows.
